In our corporate worship gatherings the preaching of the Word of God is primary. There is nothing higher. There is nothing more significant. There is nothing more affective than His Word. If you want to hear the voice of God audibly read the Bible out loud.

We are not here and we do not meet to observe or spectate. We are here to worship. How we treat the preached Word of God and respond to it is the most important thing we will do today.

I've been a part of gatherings where people walk out during the sermon or immediately after. I've heard preachers boo-ed. I've seen people criticize the preacher to his face following a service. I've heard the conversations in the restaurant where we "chew on the preacher" for lunch.

I've also been so overwhelmed by the Word of God preached that I was almost unable to approach the platform to lead the response song out of fear I'd be stricken with death because of my wickedness. I've seen people at the altar so broken and unable to function or move. I've seen people move through the aisles to ask forgiveness of family and friends not caring how long it took or who stood looking.

Preaching is the direct voice of God to His people. If a pastor is preaching on the family then it must mean we need correction and exhortation to be more Christ-like in our homes. If a preacher leads us to evaluate the origin of our ethic and moral compass then God must see a weakness in His church that needs to be addressed.

We should agree this morning, as we welcome Bro. Jim to preach, that God wants to say something to His bride. We should listen for His voice and we should respond in a Christ-like way.
